Iron Horse Moebius Scarf

Barbara's Notes: Any bulky yarn that gives you 3 stitches to the inch will work well with this. I used Pagewood Farm Swagger, because Debbie's sample used that and was gorgeous. The shade I chose is Fabulous Fall. The sample at Iron Horse is Forest Camo. One is bright orange, the other a subtle blend of browns and greens. Both look amazing when finished. Iron Horse carries half a dozen other colors of this yarn as well.*

My scarf felt small as I worked it. Debbie assured me that it would loosen up once it was off the needles and had been gently blocking (i.e., briefly soaked in a nonrinse solution like Eucalan and air dried). And it did.

Materials: 1 skein Pagewood Farms Swagger 1 24" circular needle, Size 17

Gauge: 3 sts/inch

Directions:

CO 43 sts. Join to work in the round, taking care to twist 360° at the time of the initial join. No further twist is needed, but take care during the second row that you don't inadvertently *un*twist

Work seed stitch (**K 1**, **P 1**). Since you are working in the round with an uneven number of stitches, you will always be working a knit stitch over a purl stitch, and a purl stitch over a knit stitch.

Work until you have 11/2 yards of yarn left. BO in pattern.
